

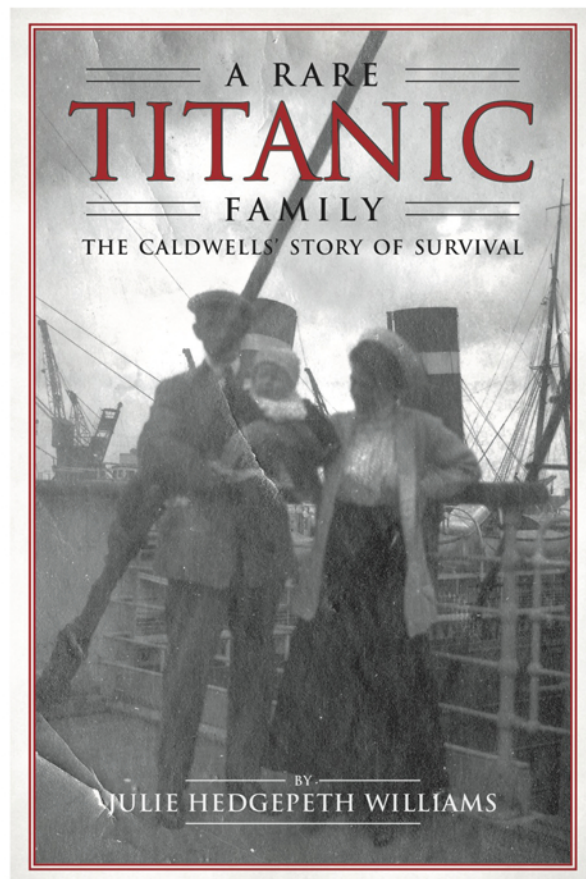
One family's unusual tale of surviving the Titanic shared for the first time in an intriguing new book

Julie Hedgepeth Williams grew up hearing the story of the Titanic from her great-uncle, Albert Caldwell, who survived the tragic 1912 shipwreck along with his wife and baby. Williams was so inspired by Caldwell's story that she majored in History (and English) at Principia College, and eventually got a Master's and a PhD at University of Alabama, both with an emphasis on media history. She teaches journalism part-time at Samford University in Birmingham. She has also taught media history at UA's own Master's in Community Journalism Program.
